



Kenton County Public Works Monthly Clean-Up

Public Works and the Solid Waste Management, hosts free monthly clean-ups at Kenton County Public Works, 420 Independence Station Rd., Independence, 41051.

One Saturday of every month from 9:00 A.M. until 2:00 P.M. (Except for Nov. and bad weather conditions)

These monthly clean-ups are intended for private Kenton County Residents. Please bring proof of residency (Driver's License with current address or your trash bill).

Not intended for Business, including side Junk/Construction Debris Removal Business.

Appliances, trash, yard waste and other junk are accepted. Car tires are accepted, but after four the fee will be \$3.00 per tire. Please tarp and strap all loads to prevent litter.

Hazardous materials, liquid waste, fluorescent bulbs, shingles, and any type of paint will NOT be accepted.



In the case of snow or ice during a clean-up time, the clean-up may be cancelled. The crews responsible for the monthly clean-up are the same crews responsible for snow removal. Please contact Public Works for updates in the case of snow or ice.

Follow the signs as you enter and the Public Works staff will be there to direct you. Please bring help with you to unload
