

Fox Run Women's Golf League – 2012

Purpose of Organization:

1. To foster camaraderie and fellowship with all members of the Kenton County Fox Run Women's Golf League.
2. To encourage new members to participate in all golfing activities from fun games and competitions during league play, to the various tournaments held throughout the season.
3. To assist women who are new to the sport of golf with their understanding of the game in terms of appropriate behavior on the course, and rules and etiquette of the game, in accordance with rules of the United States Golf Association, except as modified by the local rules of the course.

General Guidelines

1. The Fox Run Women's Golf League Board of Directors shall consist of President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Past-President/Historian, all having voting privileges, with no term limits, Advisor to the Board shall be the Golf Course Management Representative and/or its Representatives.
2. Membership is open to all women who desire to play 18 holes in organized play. Dues of \$30 include: Awards Luncheon, Awards, GHIN discount, Scoring, Event Management, Club Championship Entry, and Guest Day snacks.
3. A general membership meeting shall be held approximately 4 weeks in advance of the first play day of the upcoming season, and following the final Championship play day of the season. This season-ending meeting shall include the election of the new Board for the next year.
4. Play is on Wednesday mornings, Mid-April to the last Wednesday of September, on the Fox Run Golf Course, with consecutive starting tee times beginning at 8:00 a.m., with a double start on 1 and 10, if membership fields 50 or more players. A shotgun start remains in effect on Guest Day.
5. A set schedule for the season, including times and pairing, shall be issued to members in a timely fashion, following the close of registration. April 1st.
6. Pairings are random, tee-times are random. Currently, players will fall into two flights: Championship and First, based on GHIN/ESC handicaps.

The Game

1. 18-Hole Play on the Fox Run Golf Course
2. All members will receive one point for their participation in weekly play, with a turned-in, completed scorecard.
3. Individual points are awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Low Net and Low Gross by Flight each week; exception, Guest Day.
4. Flights are set at beginning of season; flights remain same for season. Random pairings will be between Flights.
5. Consecutive starting times—see above.
6. All members are expected to play as scheduled. Members may cancel by emailing the General Manager by 12:00 Noon the day before play day. Members failing to follow above procedure, or playing out of schedule, will be assessed a 5-point deduction. In case of emergency or illness on play day, call the golf shop (859-371-3200) as soon as possible...your playing partners are waiting.

7. Members should arrive at least 30 minutes before their tee time to insure paperwork be complete, carts loaded, leaving adequate time to check in with the Fox Run Starter.

8. A member late for her tee time may still join her group. Member must record a 10 for each hole passed in order to catch up.

9. Inclement weather policy: If over 50% of scheduled players complete the round, it is an official game day. If less than 50% of the scheduled players complete the round, the game is cancelled, with participation points awarded as follows—1/2 point for all participants turning in a scorecard.

10. Guest Day. Members may use a G Card on the monthly Guest Day. Members may invite up to 3 guests to play in modified scramble formats. Members not bringing guests may make their own group with other members. Staff will make the game and the hole assignments. 8:00 a.m. shotgun start; light snacks and drinks available after event. Sign-up sheet available in golf shop approximately two weeks in advance of each guest week.

The Play

1. Play your own ball.
2. Only one scorecard needs to be turned in for each tee time.
3. When not furnished, print names on scorecards, sign and turn into box in golf shop.
4. Staff will score events and email results.
5. Carts dispatched normally.

Rules Specific to Fox Run Women's Golf League

1. All members must maintain USGA Handicap.
2. All members are expected to play on time, each play day...see above.
3. All play will be from the white tees.
4. Ball will be played up through the green; players can move ball up to a scorecard length.
5. Maximum competitive handicap is 42.
6. All putts must be holed.
7. Upon completion of play, minimum of two players must sign the scorecard.
8. All non-maintained areas to the right and left of the fairway, including over the green, will be played as lateral hazards. Drop ball at nearest point where the ball last crossed into the area, no closer to the hole, taking one penalty stroke.
9. Acceptable Pace of Play if 4.5 hours.
10. Players are responsible for entering their own scores in the GHIN, Flight Captains will periodically monitor.
11. On play day, cell 'phones must be turned off or set to vibrate.

Other Games

1. Ringers. Staff will tabulate your best 18 holes for the year, updating a master score sheet with your best score on each hole for the year.
2. Chip-Ins (Optional). Players put in 50 cents BEFORE play. Chip-ins paid out that day, or carry over to next week if not won. Players need to mark scorecard with a square on the hole where the chip-in occurred.
3. Hole-in-One Club (Optional). Participating Fox Run Women's Golf League members may enter this club by signing-on in the golf shop, depositing \$5.00 into the

fund. Pay out goes to any member getting a witnessed hole-in-one, at any time, on any of the three Kenton County golf courses.

4. Sponsoring Annual 9 & 18 hole ladies' league member/alumni brunch the 1st Monday of August.

5. Sponsoring Annual Partners Event the last Sunday of September.
