WHEREAS, in December, 2020, the Campbell County Jailer Jim Daley, and the Campbell County Fiscal Court made available their Class D/Work Release facility in Newport, KY for homeless sheltering for the winter season; and

WHEREAS, Due to fire code and COVID, the Emergency Shelter of Northern Kentucky facility on Scott Street only allowed for 30 overnight guests, so the Campbell County Fiscal Court under direction of Judge/Executive Steve Penderly worked to open their facility to accommodate a population of 65-68 guests; and

WHEREAS the Kenton County Fiscal Court would like to recognize the Campbell County Jailer Jim Daley, as well as the Campbell County Fiscal Court's efforts towards the regional homelessness issue; and
