RESOLUTION NO. 21-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CITY OF PARK HILLS TO PURSUE MATCHING FEDERAL SNK FUNDS FROM THE OHIO-KENTUCKY-INDIANA (OKI) REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE AMSTERDAM ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, Amsterdam Road between the points of Sleepy Hollow Road (KY 1072) and Hamilton Road is a 0.577 mile multi-modal road that provides an east-west link through the City of Park Hills and serves as part of a critical connector between the neighborhoods of Covington, Fort Wright, Park Hills, and unincorporated Kenton County, and;

WHEREAS, this section of roadway is an important alternative route for travelers from these neighborhoods to Covington and Cincinnati when construction and congestion occurs along I-75 throughout the Brent Spence Bridge corridor, and;

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court desires to partner with the City of Park Hills by authorizing the services of the County Engineer's office to assist with the pursuit of an SNK grant and the management of the project through the phases of Design, Right-of-Way, Utilities, and Construction, and;

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court will provide services at its cost to the City of Park Hills and will provide no direct monetary contribution to the project, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Park Hills must provide 20% of the gross amount of the grant, and;

WHEREAS, the City will make necessary appropriation for said match upon successful award of an SNK Grant in the 2022 Fiscal Year budget, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Kenton County Fiscal Court does hereby authorize a partnership with the City of Park Hills to assist in the pursuit of 80% matching Federal SNK funds from the OKI Regional Council of Governments and will, upon award of grant, authorize staff to act as Project Manager for the OKI Amsterdam Road Reconstruction Project.
