Programs

- ▶ 125 Intensive Inpatient Programing, 90 male, 35 Female
- ▶ 70 Intensive Outpatient Programing
- ▶ MOUD Services, SHP & St.E
- ▶ Reentry Services, KCDC
- ▶ Aftercare Services, St E & Life Learning Center
- ▶ Work Programs, Class D, Kitchen, Trustee
- ▶ MRT Programming, DOC
- ▶ GED, Gateway Community College

Outcomes 1 Year Post Completion

Source, Life Learning Center & UK's CJKTOS

- ▶ 68% did not reoffend, LLC Data 2017-2020
- ▶ 84.5% were living in stable housing, CJKTOS 2020
- ▶ 72.0% were employed, CJKTOS 2020
- ▶ 73.5% of those with children reported providing financial support to their children, CJKTOS 2020
- ▶ 64.9% did not have a positive drug test in the year since release, CJKTOS
- ▶ 65.3% attended 12-Step meetings, CJKTOS 2020
- ▶ 69.7% of those referred to aftercare, attended aftercare, CJKTOS 2020
- ▶ For every \$1 spent on Kentucky corrections-based substance use disorder treatment there is a \$3.63 cost offset, CJKTOS 2020
