ORDINANCE NO. 950.90

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE KENTON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AND VARIOUS KENTON COUNTY
CITIES FOR THE KENTON COUNTY JOINT CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court wishes to revise the Kenton County Joint Code Enforcement Board Interlocal Agreement previously adopted by Ordinance 950.87 on April 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Kenton County Planning and Development Services, hereinafter referred to as “PDS” (and formerly known as Northern Kentucky Area Planning “NKAPC”) has adopted a new fee distribution model for the costs associated with administering the code enforcement board program for cities and the county; and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court believes it to be in the best interests of the cities and county to adopt the amended cost distribution model as set out in Exhibit “A”, attached; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Kenton County Fiscal Court, County of Kenton, Kentucky, as follows:

Section I

That the amendments to the “*Interlocal Agreement for the Kenton County Joint Code Enforcement Board*” attached as Exhibit “A” are hereby approved and adopted.

Section II

That the Judge/Executive of Kenton County shall be and is now authorized and directed to execute the Amended “*Interlocal Agreement for the Kenton County Joint Code Enforcement Board*” for and on behalf of Kenton County and the Kenton County Fiscal Court.

Section III

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
