EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-101

IN RE: Reorganization of Kenton County Public Works and Fleet Services

WHEREAS: Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge-Executive, has the authority under the statutes of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to provide for the restructuring and reorganization of county government upon the approval of the Fiscal Court of the County of Kenton, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS: Kris A. Knochelmann has determined it is in the best interest of the residents of Kenton County to reorganize the structure of the Public Works and Fleet Services Department in county government; and

WHEREAS: Kris A. Knochelmann has determined by reorganizing the department, it will insure the success in its goal of making county government more efficient and effective in its operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge-Executive, do hereby order that the Kenton County Public Works and Fleet Services Department shall be reorganized effective August 18, 2021 as follows:

1. Establish the position of "Public Services Technician – Seasonal" (PST Seasonal) and add capacity for 8 such positions to the Public Works organizational chart. The wage for this position will range from \$18.00 to \$25.00 per hour based on experience.
2. Establish the position of Fleet Services Office Manager at Grade 6 (\$20.22 - \$25.22) to replace the existing Administrative Assistant position in the Fleet Services Division. The proposed position will assume all of the duties of the existing position and be tasked with additional responsibilities as detailed in the position description.
