

PUBLIC SERVICES TECHNICIAN - SEASONAL

GENERAL NATURE OF WORK

Characteristics of a job are general statements indicating the level of responsibility and discretion of positions in that job classification. These are not intended to be an exhaustive list.

Performs a variety of general Entry Level labor functions and operates basic automotive and power equipment such as (but not limited to) bush hogs, chainsaws, chemical sprayers, chippers, jack hammers, mowing tractors, single axle truck (dump, flatbed, pickup), snow plow and salt spreaders, broom sweepers, and weed trimmers; and performs other duties as assigned. Assists with beginning level engineering related small technical tasks in support of construction and/or maintenance programs; and performs other duties as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Examples of duties or responsibilities are not to be construed as describing what the duties or responsibilities of any position shall be and are not to be construed as limiting the appointing authority's ability to assign, or otherwise alter the duties and responsibilities of a position. This is not intended to be an exhaustive list.

Performs a variety of general labor functions such as patching potholes, picking up litter, using chainsaw to trim trees and brush, and serves as flagger during maintenance activities. Install traffic signs. Operates basic equipment such as, but not limited to bush hogs, chainsaws, chippers, jack hammers, mowing tractors, single axle truck (dump, flatbed, pickup), snow plow and salt spreaders, broom sweepers, and weed trimmers. Performs duties associated with the County's snow and ice policies. Attends required training classes. Performs additional duties as assigned.

DESIRABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

High school graduate.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Must be 18 years of age. Must possess a valid driver's license prior to appointment in this classification. Employee in this classification must furnish within 2 months of appointment that he or she holds a valid Class B Commercial driver's license.

Must maintain any required licensure(s), certification(s), or other credentials for the length of employment in this classification. Employing agency is responsible for ensuring employee possesses and maintains required licensure(s), certification(s), or other credentials.

Must be able to respond to emergencies and be on call 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Upon appointment, employees in this class shall be required to maintain a valid driver's license and may be required to

drive a licensed vehicle. This status shall be necessary for the length of time in this class. Applicants and employees in this job title shall be required to submit to a drug screening test and background check.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Must be able to lift (80) pounds or more to a height of four (4) feet or more.

Must be able to work extended periods of time using heavy duty powered hand tools such as chain saws, weed eaters, compaction equipment, jack hammers, etc. or to use hand tools such as hammers, shovels, rakes, etc.

Must be able to work extended hours in weather conditions which may range from extreme heat to extreme cold and which frequently may be inclement.

Must be able to work at heights of twenty (20) feet or more.

Must be able to sit, stand or walk for extended periods of time.

Eye sight must correctable to 20/20 vision.

Hearing must be within normal acceptable range of 20-25 with or without a hearing aid.

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

The above Job Description is intended to describe the general content of, and the requirements for, the performance of this job, including essential functions. The descriptions is not to be construed as an exhaustive, all-inclusive statement of job duties, requirements, or responsibilities.
