EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-120

IN RE: Reorganization of Kenton County Treasury Department

WHEREAS: Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge-Executive, has the authority under the statutes of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to provide for the restructuring and reorganization of county government upon the approval of the Fiscal Court of the County of Kenton, Kentucky; and

1. Establish the position of COLA Liaison within the Business Services Division of the Treasury at Grade 11 (\$61,219-\$76,236). The proposed job descriptions are attached
