

RESOLUTION NO. 22-04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (USDOT) FOR MATCHING FEDERAL RAISE GRANT FUNDS FOR THE WIDENING AND REALIGNMENT OF KY 536 FROM CALVARY DRIVE TO KY 17 IN INDEPENDENCE

WHEREAS, KY 536 between the points of Calvary Drive and KY 17 is a 1.93 mile section of road that links unincorporated Kenton County and the City of Independence to I-75 in Florence, and;

WHEREAS, this section is the logical extension of the active project being constructed from the Boone County line to KY 1303 and an adjacent project section, and will complete a roadway and multi-use path connection between Calvary Drive and KY 17 in the City of Independence, and;

WHEREAS, a construction estimate of \$23,790,000 for this section has been established and successful grant applications are predicated on non-federal funding match from participating local governments and private industry, and;

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court commits to appropriate up to \$1,000,000 over a 1-3 year period after grant acceptance for said match, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Kenton County Fiscal Court does hereby commit to make application to the United States Department of Transportation for matching federal RAISE Grant funds, and shall commit over a 1-3 year period to provide a local match for the awarded KY 536 Widening and Realignment Project.
