**ORDINANCE NO. 532.20**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KENTON COUNTY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES  
PLACING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON STREETS LOCATED IN  
UNINCORPORATED KENTON COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Kenton County Fiscal Court has established uniform traffic regulations for roads in the County of Kenton, Kentucky, which are now included in the Kenton County Code of Ordinances Chapter 71; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kenton County Public Works, Engineering Services Department studied the need for additional traffic control devices on Alderbrook Drive and Blue Ash Lane, at the intersection of the two routes, located in unincorporated Kenton County, Kentucky, and in conjunction with the Kenton County Police, is requesting that said traffic control device be placed; and

**WHEREAS**, the posting of a stop sign on eastbound Alderbrook Drive at its intersection with Blue Ash Lane, and the posting of stop signs on northbound and southbound Blue Ash Lane at its intersection with Alderbrook Drive, will create a 3-way stop condition that will provide for safe ingress/egress through said intersection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Kenton County Fiscal Court, County of Kenton, Kentucky, as follows:

**Section I**

The Kenton County Fiscal Court approves an amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 71: Traffic Schedules, Schedule II, Traffic Control Devices, which will authorize the placement of one stop sign on eastbound Alderbrook Drive at its intersection with Blue Ash Drive, and the placement of one stop sign on northbound and one stop sign on southbound Blue Ash Drive at its intersection with Alderbrook Drive, unincorporated Kenton County, Kentucky and directs that the Engineering Services Department of Public Works place the necessary signage.

**Section II**

The penalty for a violation of this Ordinance shall be as set forth in the Kentucky Revised Statutes 189.990.

**Section III**

That any section, or part of any section, or any provision of this Ordinance which is declared invalid by a Court of appropriate jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section IV**

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
