**IN RE: Reorganization of Kenton County Animal Services**

**WHEREAS:** Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge-Executive, has the authority under the statutes of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to provide for the restructuring and reorganization of county government upon the approval of the Fiscal Court of the County of Kenton, Kentucky; and

**WHEREAS:** Kris A. Knochelmann has determined it is in the best interest of the residents of Kenton County to reorganize the structure of the Animal Services Department in county government; and

**WHEREAS:** Kris A. Knochelmann has determined by reorganizing the department, it will ensure the success in its goal of making county government more efficient and effective in its operations.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge-Executive, do hereby order that Kenton County Animal Services shall be reorganized effective September 14, 2022 as follows:

1. Establish one part-time veterinary assistant at Grade 3 (\$17.00-\$21.20).
2. Add one full-time Shelter Technician at Grade 2 (\$15.35-\$18.41)
3. Establish one full-time Animal Behavior Coordinator at Grade 3 (\$17.00-\$21.20).
