

## **RESOLUTION NO. 22-21**

### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF ARP FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE JUDGE/EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION WITH SD1, NIXUTIL SANITATION ASSOCIATION, AND ONE HOLLAND TO FACILITATE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXISTING PACKAGE SEWER TREATMENT PLANT SYSTEM FOR TRANSITION TO THE SANITATION DISTRICT ONE SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, a proposed commercial development at the northeast corner of the intersection of KY 16 and KY 17 is being led by One Holland, and;

**WHEREAS**, said development will necessitate the construction of a main sanitary sewer line in the area and along properties adjacent to KY 16, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Nixutil Sanitation Association is an aging package sewer treatment plant that serves residential and commercial properties in Unincorporated Kenton County on KY 16, Bel Aire Place, Lincoln Drive, and Catalina Drive, and;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed main sewer line presents an opportunity to connect all properties that are currently being served by the Nixutil Sanitation Association to the public sewer system owned and maintained by Sanitation District One (SD1), and;

**WHEREAS**, One Holland has agreed to partner with members of the Nixutil Sanitation Association for purposes of connecting the system to the proposed SD1 main line and decommissioning the existing package treatment plant, and;

**WHEREAS**, SD1 has agreed to said connection and to accept the properties currently served by the package plant on the condition that identified deficiencies throughout the system are corrected in advance of the proposed connection; and;

**WHEREAS**, the correction of deficiencies in the existing system have an estimated cost of \$160,000, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Kenton County Fiscal Court agrees to utilize American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding in an amount not to exceed \$160,000 to correct identified deficiencies and make necessary improvements to facilitate the transition for these properties from the Nixutil Sanitation Association to the public SD1 system, and;

**WHEREAS**, in consideration of the investment into the community and the sanitation system, the Nixutil Sanitation Association agrees to transfer a portion of the property at 11961 Catalina Drive to the Kenton County Fiscal Court for the purposes of constructing a cul-de-sac with a future project, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

The Kenton County Fiscal Court does hereby allocate the necessary funding to facilitate the transition of the Nixutil Sanitation Association to the public SD1 system and authorizes the Judge/Executive to execute all necessary documents required to partner with SD1, Nixutil Sanitation Association, and One Holland for these purposes.
