The Department of Homeland Security – CISA offers free cyber hygiene services to state and local governments. This includes continuous external vulnerability scans on our network and environment. Regular external vulnerability scans are an integral part of identifying security risks, and are strongly recommended to all institutions. It is a key eligibility requirement for cybersecurity related grant funding.

There is no cost for this service, and the scanning process is designed to be as unobtrusive as possible, as it does not in any way modify or penetrate our internal network.

The enclosed document authorizes CISA to perform these external vulnerability scans, and we are entitled to revoke authorization at any time.
