Re: IPS Contract for Cameras at Animal Shelter

Attached is IPS Proposal 311709-2-0 for labor, parts, and licensing to incorporate an IP camera system covering exterior and interior locations at the Kenton County Animal Shelter.

This project includes a total of 16 cameras, including 2 exterior 360 degree cameras, 1 interior 360 degree camera, 3 exterior single view cameras, and 10 interior single view cameras. The proposal also includes the appropriate networking hardware and cabling to facilitate a complete system.

All devices will be tied in to the existing access control system and security camera system currently in use at other Kenton County sites (including 1840 Simon Kenton Way, Historic Independence Courthouse, Police/Dispatch). This enables all cameras to be viewed and monitored from an off-site location and centrally managed.

The total project cost for this site is \$37,098.00, paid from the FY24 Capital Fund (809901-5721).
