**A RESOLUTION OF THE FISCAL COURT OF KENTON  
COUNTY, KENTUCKY HONORING THE RETIREMENT OF  
JASON DUDAS .**

**WHEREAS:** **Jason Dudas** has been at TBNK for 25 years. He is set to retire the same date he started in 1998. Jason was initially hired as the Government Channel Coordinator to oversee the production of the video coverage of TBNK Member Cities and Fiscal Court meetings, and to program air-times for those meetings on the Government Channel. He was eventually promoted to Program Director at TBNK, as he took on more duties to oversee all production for TBNK's Public and Educational operations. He also worked on the public video classes and public use of the TV Studio, edit bays and field equipment and related services, as well as the air-time offered to the public and to local Northern Kentucky civic and community service organizations; and

**WHEREAS:** **Jason Dudas** has gone above and beyond and enthusiastically has helped TBNK to produce professional, high quality public service programming for and about Northern Kentucky. Jason has also been instrumental in 25 years of TBNK's NKY Votes Election Night Results programs at the TBNK as well as many years of election debates and campaign speaker forums leading up to election day; and

**WHEREAS:** **Jason Dudas** has also produced or overseen numerous documentaries about local landmarks, areas of interest, and history of Northern Kentucky for TBNK's Discover NKY program. In addition to his exemplary efforts on a daily basis to help develop and expand our local Northern Kentucky focused programming, Jason's work on producing individual programs has been recognized with national awards including the Telly Awards and Communicator Awards. Jason has also won numerous Blue Chip Community Media Awards recognizing excellence in local Greater Cincinnati community media programming; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Kenton County Kentucky Fiscal Court wishes to recognize **Jason Dudas'** service to our community, and thank him for his years of dedicated service to the citizens of Kenton County.
