EXECUTIVE ORDER 23-112

RE: Reorganization of Kenton County Animal Services Department

WHEREAS: Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge/Executive, has the authority to appoint, promote, discipline, and terminate from employment, employees of the County of Kenton, Kentucky with approval of the Fiscal Court; and

WHEREAS: Kris A. Knochelmann has been advised the need to accept the reorganization of the Kenton County Animal Services Department; and

NOW THEREFORE, I, Kris A. Knochelmann, Kenton County Judge/Executive, do hereby order that the Kenton County Animal Services Department shall be reorganized effective August 30, 2023 as follows:

1. Reclassify current vacant position of part-time Veterinary Assistant to a full-time position at a Grade 3 (\$18.96 - \$\$25.65)
2. Add one full-time Shelter Technician + TNR Specialist at a Grade 2 (\$17.37 - \$23.50)
3. Establish one full-time Shelter Veterinarian at a Grade 13 (\$40.42 - \$54.69)
