

RESOLUTION NO. 24-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF KENTON, KENTUCKY
REPEALING THE LICENSE FEE ON RESTAURANT, RETAIL OUTLET OF SOFT
DRINKS OR ICE CREAM, BILLIARD OR POOL TABLES, AND RETAIL TOBACCO
PRODUCTS ADOPTED BY RESOLUTION DATED JUNE 2, 1960**

WHEREAS, in 1960 the Kentucky General Assembly enacted House Bill 75 giving authority to Fiscal Courts to impose a license for restaurant, retail outlet of soft drinks or ice cream, billiard or pool table, and retail tobacco products; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 1960, at a regular meeting of the Kenton County Fiscal Court a Resolution was adopted to impose a license for restaurant, retail outlet of soft drinks or ice cream, billiard or pool table and tobacco products effective July 1, 1960, said fee renewing each July 1 thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the June 2, 1960, resolution adopted a fee schedule between five and thirty dollars for the various business types; and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Treasurer has informed the Fiscal Court that the costs associated with the collection of these licensing fees exceeds the income received by the fees and recommends repealing the Resolution adopted on June 2, 1960, adopting the fees for those businesses subject to House Bill 75;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. That the Kenton County Fiscal Court hereby repeals the licensing fees set out by Resolution adopted on June 2, 1960; and
2. That beginning July 1, 2024, restaurant, retail outlet of soft drinks or ice cream, billiard or pool table and tobacco product businesses previously required to pay a fee as set out by Resolution adopted June 2, 1960, shall no longer be required to pay said fee.
