ORDINANCE NO. 532.26

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KENTON COUNTY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES
ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON STREETS LOCATED IN
UNINCORPORATED KENTON COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Kenton County has established uniform traffic regulations for roads in the County of Kenton, Kentucky, which are now included in the Kenton County Code of Ordinances Chapter 71: Schedule I, Speed Limits; and

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Public Works Director has studied the need for the reduction of the speed limit on Goshorn Rd, located in unincorporated Kenton County, Kentucky, and, in conjunction with the Kenton County Police, is requesting that said speed limit be reduced; and

WHEREAS, the reduction of the speed limit described herein will provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Kenton County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Kenton County Fiscal Court, County of Kenton, Kentucky, as follows:

Section I

Schedule I, Subsection (A) of Chapter 71 of the Kenton County Code of Ordinances (532.14) is hereby amended to reduce the speed limit from 35 miles per hour and establish the speed limit to 25 miles per hour and further directs that the road be posted as such at the following location in unincorporated Kenton County:

1. Goshorn Road:

Section II

The penalty for a violation of this Ordinance shall be as set forth in the Kentucky Revised Statutes 189.990.

Section III

That any section, or part of any section, or any provision of this Ordinance which is declared invalid by a Court of appropriate jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section IV

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
