ORDINANCE NO. 620.14**

**AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING LYNN STREET**

**WHEREAS**, Lynn Street is a public roadway in Kenton County, Commonwealth of Kentucky, and

**WHEREAS**, the Kenton County Fiscal Court was made aware of the need to close Lynn Street in Unincorporated Kenton County for the purposes of expediting development of the surrounding property; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Road Closure Committee comprised of two disinterested viewers along with the County Engineer met to consider closing Lynn Street in Unincorporated Kenton County; and

**WHEREAS**, all utility easements contained within the discontinued portion of the right-of-way will remain and be retained by the current owners of said easements; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Road Closure Committee has reported that Lynn Street serves no public purpose and has not been accessible for many years, and as such no inconvenience would result from its discontinuance; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of 178.070, including all required posting, viewing and advertisement, pursuant to KRS 178.050 and KRS Chapter 424 have been met; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Court believes the closure of Lynn Street will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Kenton County;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF KENTON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, THAT:**

**Section I**

The Kenton County Fiscal Court hereby discontinues Lynn Street in Unincorporated Kenton County, further described as follows: From a point at intersection with Anderson Road approximately 1,044 linear feet continuing northwest along the centerline of Lynn Street to terminus. The Fiscal Court acting pursuant to KRS 178.070, makes the following findings:

1. The report of the County Road Closure Committee, having been reduced to writing and presented at public hearing, is hereby adopted.

2. The discontinued portion of Lynn Street does not result in any inconvenience to any property owners and/or residents of Kenton County.
3. The discontinued roadway has not been maintained by Kenton County.

**Section II**

That should any section or part of any section or any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, for any reason, such declaration shall not invalidate, or adversely affect, the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section III**

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to law.
