

## **Management Control Agreement**

The Kenton County Emergency Communications Center (KCECC), a Central Dispatch Agency under control of the Kenton County Emergency Communications Board, as defined in *Kenton County Code of Ordinances, Title III, Chapter 33 Emergency Communications Board*, whose duty is to “serve as the administrative and policy-making organization for all matters relating to the provision of public safety communication/dispatching services” and furthermore, “shall exist as an autonomous body to oversee all related emergency dispatching functions, in accordance with this subchapter or any amendments thereto and state law” on which pursuant to the required bylaws the Kenton County Police Chief has a permanent seat is entering into the following Management Control Agreement with the Kenton County Police Department, a Criminal Justice Agency to ensure all applicable legal requirements are met in the dissemination of information to law enforcement/first responders and to provide the best and most efficient 911 services/emergency dispatching functions possible to protect and serve all first responders and citizens of Kenton County, Kentucky.

Pursuant to the CJIS Security Policy, it is agreed that with respect to administration of that portion of computer systems and network infrastructure interfacing directly or indirectly with the state network, LINK for the interstate exchange of criminal history/criminal justice information, the Kenton County Police Department shall have the authority, via managed control, to set, maintain, and enforce only those portions listed:

- (1) Priorities.
- (2) Standards for the selection, supervision, and termination of personnel access to Criminal Justice Information (CJI).
- (3) Policy governing operation of justice systems, computers, access devices, circuits, hubs, routers, firewalls, and any other components, including encryption, that comprise and support a telecommunications network and related criminal justice systems to include but not limited to criminal history record/criminal justice information, insofar as the equipment is used to process or transmit criminal justice systems information guaranteeing the priority, integrity, and availability of service needed by the criminal justice community.
- (4) Restriction of unauthorized personnel from access or use of equipment accessing the State network.
- (5) Compliance with all rules and regulations of the Kenton County Police Department Policies and CJIS Security Policy in the operation of all information received.

“...management control of the criminal justice function remains solely with the Criminal Justice Agency.” Section 5.1.1.4

The Kenton County Emergency Communications Center will remain the physical location of the terminal with all the rights and responsibilities outlined in the most recent signed *Law Information Network of Kentucky Terminal Agency User Agreement* by and between the Kentucky State Police and the Kenton County Police Department User Agency Head as the continued sole provider of services to the below listed agencies as outlined in the current signed *Law Information Network of Kentucky Satellite Agency User Agreement* by and between each Satellite Agency Head and Terminal Agency Head.
