

# RESOLUTION 851-2020

A resolution by the Planning and Development Services Management Board  
levying a tax on all real property, inventory, inventory in transit,  
motor vehicles, watercraft, and other personal property in  
Kenton County to cover the organization's Fiscal Year 2021 operations.

**WHEREAS** the Planning and Development Services Management Board is responsible under law and the terms of numerous interlocal agreements for initiatives critical to the collective health, safety, and welfare of its member local governments and their citizens in accordance with provisions of KRS Chapters 65, 65A, 99, 100, and 147; and

**WHEREAS** the Planning and Development Services Management Board developed a proposed budget detailing anticipated revenues and expenditures and a proposed tax rate for its Fiscal Year 2021 operations in accordance with provisions of KRS Chapter 147; and

**WHEREAS** the Planning and Development Services Council approved that budget of \$5,866,292 during its meeting held on June 18, 2020 in accordance with provisions of KRS Chapter 147; and

**WHEREAS** the 2020 compensating rate as certified by the Department of Local Government is 0.029 per \$100 valuation on all real property; and

**WHEREAS** the Planning and Development Services Management Board must levy a 2020 tax rate to fund that budget in accordance with KRS Chapters 132, 147, and other applicable statutes; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED** that the Planning and Development Services Management Board levies a tax rate that equals \$0.0268 per \$100 valuation on all real property and inventory in transit in Kenton County as of January 1, 2020; and, be it further

**RESOLVED** that the Planning and Development Services Management Board levies a tax rate that equals \$0.0268 per \$100 valuation on all motor vehicles, watercraft, and other personal property in Kenton County as of January 1, 2020; and, be it finally


