Code Enforcement Tidbits


According to the Appraisal Institute, unkempt yards and poorly maintained exteriors can reduce the value of surrounding homes by as much as five to ten percent.

Time: 7:00 PM


Where: Oak Ridge Baptist Church, 6056 Taylor Mill Rd, Covington, KY 41015

Our Success Stories

There have been ten visits in the last year from State Senators, the County Judge/Executive, several County Commissioners, and numerous state and local officials to support Latonia Lakes.

Residents of Latonia Lakes are very actively engaged in community events geared towards improving Latonia Lakes. These events include a Town Hall meeting with the Fiscal Court; a door-to-door petition drive that was presented to the Judge/Executive; several community work days; and several community wide cleanups with the County, NKU, People Working Cooperatively, and the Boy Scouts.

Kenton County Public Works has moved trash cans and signs around the lake, cleaned out the overflow pipe to the lake, and cleaned up both sides of the hillside on the lake property. The Public Works Department also provided dumpsters for the September cleanup event.

The Fiscal Court initiated an engineering study to determine different road repair and dam repair options and costs.

There are conversations with Duke Energy about turning on some of the street lights around the lake.

Oak Ridge Baptist Church has given their full support to the Latonia Lakes community. They have participated in community meals, several cleanup efforts (including the lake), and actively meet with local officials and residents to discuss progress in Latonia Lakes.
