LITTER LETTER GUIDELINES

As part of the Trash for Cash Agreement, each group is required to write a (200-word limit) letter to describe the experience with picking-up roadside littered trash. This letter intended to spread the word about litter to our neighbors and to educate the public about the problems litter creates.

Please keep the following guidelines in mind when you write this letter:

- Talk about your experience. How did you organize your cleanup? What did you find? Did anything surprise you? What conversations did the experience generate about litter in our community?
- Share your thoughts about litter. What was it like to pick up other people's trash? What did you learn? What would you like to tell your neighbors about how litter affects our community?
- Please do not thank Kenton County. The purpose of this letter is to spread the word about why litter is gross, not to promote our organization.
