APPENDIX 6

FEDERAL UNIFIED COMMAND ORGANIZATION

I. SITUATION AND ASSUMPTIONS

- A. The Federal government, on arrival at the scene of a terrorism event, will establish a command system based on the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and a Joint Operations Center (JOC). The FBI will be the lead agency.
- B. The Unified Command and JOC will be supported by a Joint Information Center (JIC) – see Kenton County JIC Plan for additional details.

II. MISSION

- A. Provide effective management of the terrorism incident.

III. DIRECTION AND CONTROL

- A. NIMS will be used by all responders.
- B. The JOC will conform to the JOC structure diagramed in Tab 6-2.
- C. The transition from the initial response to a terrorism incident to the establishment of the Unified Command System and the JOC will follow the time line laid out in Tab 6-3.
